GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY: Good Shepherd Sunday is celebrated on Sunday, April 25, 2021. On this day, Jesus speaks to us as the Good Shepherd calling His flock to actively follow Him. It is a call to discipleship, and Father Michał Czyżewski, OSPPE, pastor of St. Stanislaus Bishop & Martyr Church, points out that "its significance resides in the fact that it is the perfect time to pray for our priests, bishops, the pope, and all those who shepherd the Lord's flock. We need to ask the Holy Spirit to inspire those in authority and to help them lead our faithful to become active participants and witnesses to Christ's everlasting love." This Sunday is also known as Vocations Sunday. Father Michał urges everyone to pray for vocations to the priesthood and to religious life. Jesus, as the good shepherd, calls His sheep by name, and the sheep recognize His voice and follow Him. "We need to be grateful for the shepherds who guide us in the footsteps of Christ. We need to support, encourage, and pray for them."
