 **From the Diocese of Buffalo...**



“In light of the updated Covid guidelines, I have decided to officially end the dispensation from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass as of the weekend of **June 5 and 6, 2021**.

We have made the decision not to verify the vaccination of each and every parishioner. As such, we request that at all Masses and parish events, masks should continue to be worn upon entry and exit, and at any time when there is movement or a closeness to others, for instance, when the Communion procession forms. (Ministers of the Eucharist should be masked when distributing Communion as should those receiving.) When seated, or when at an outdoor gathering, masks may be removed at the discretion of the individual.

It is reasonable that we also continue to observe social distancing guidelines during the celebration of Mass and other liturgies.”

The “**Road to Renewal**” is an initiative to revitalize and reinvigorate our Catholic Faith through the optimization of resources and the strengthening of our parish communities. Father Bryan Zielenieski, Diocesan Vicar for Renewal and Development, posts regular YouTube updates on the progress of the process (<https://roadtorenewal.org>). In his latest broadcast, Father Bryan discussed the five pillars that the “**Road to Renewal**” will be focusing on. These pillars are: (1) The Family of Parishes (2) Spirituality (3) The Catholic Center (4) Catholic Education and (5) Priestly Life and Healing.

A family of parishes will be a grouping of parishes that comes together to form a family. Each family will contain three to six parishes that will comprise the family and provide shared priestly ministry (especially with the declining number of priests available), collaboration, and sharing of strengths and resources. The tentative “draft” family of parishes for our area includes St. Stanislaus Bishop & Martyr Church, Corpus Christi Church, St. John Kanty Church, and St. John Gualbert Church.


As a family, all these parishes will remain independent entities. The finances of each parish will remain their own, and there is no plan or intent to close any of the parishes. Since there are questions that have arisen and ideas offered, the Renewal office is using the summer months to better clarify the process. 
