A MESSAGE FROM MOST REV. MICHAEL W. FISHER, BISHOP OF BUFFALO. Many follow the instruction of abstaining from meat on Fridays during Lent, but we are also called to practice self-discipline and fast in other ways throughout the season. This year Saint Patrick’s Day falls on Friday, a traditional day to abstain from eating meat. Recognizing the spiritual and the cultural significance of Saint Patrick’s Day, **I hereby grant a commutation of the discipline of abstaining from meat on March 17, 2023. A commutation of this discipline means that those Catholics who choose to eat meat on Friday, March 17 are obliged to choose another day before March 24, 2023 to abstain from eating meat.**

EASTER EGG RAFFLE. We are having a raffle of wooden Easter eggs, thanks to the generosity of Mark Boyland and the late Rita Boyland. Tickets will be available before and after weekend Masses at \$1 each or 6 tickets for \$5. The drawing will take place on Palm Sunday, April 2.
