In the schedule of “Diocesan Collections for the Year 2020”, it was noted that during the month of September 2020, there will be a second collection to benefit Christ the King Seminary.

With the timing of decision to close Christ the King Seminary and our ability to communicate that change with the parish envelope providers, you still have received an envelope designed for that purpose. Regardless of the designation, collection proceeds will be use for the diocesan “Formation” operating budget.

The Formation operating budget consists largely of tuition expenses for seminarians and diaconate candidates. Seminarians from our diocese are pursuing their studies either at St. Mary’s Seminary in Baltimore or, if they are a final year seminarian with a May 2021 ordination date, still at Christ the King (but only for this academic year). Diaconate candidates are pursuing their studies through our new collaboration with St. Bernard’s School of Theology in Rochester in a combination of in-person classes and remote learning. Thank you for your generosity and understanding.

Remember St. Stanislaus Parish in Your Will: Making out, or updating your will is a good thing to do as things can change in our lives more quickly than we realize.
